CHIEFTAINCY (STATUS OF CHIEFS) ACT, 1972¹⁽¹⁾

AN ACT to remove doubts as to the status of certain chiefs.

Effect of Chieftaincy repeals

For the avoidance of doubts it is hereby declared that the repeal by section 67 of the Chieftaincy Act, 1971 (Act 370) of the Decrees specified in the Schedule to this Decree shall not be deemed to have affected the status of any chief, stool or skin as it existed immediately before the repeal.
