**NO. 41**  
**WORLD HEALTH ORGANISATION (PROTECTION) ACT, 1958(1)**

**AN ACT to make provision for the prevention of abuse of the World Health Organisation's official seal, emblem and name.**

**1. Improper use of the Organisation's emblem**

A person, without the authority of the Minister responsible for Health, shall not use for a purpose

- (a) the design in the Schedule which is the official seal and emblem of the World Health Organisation, or
- (b) the designation "World Health Organisation" or an abbreviation of that designation.

**2. Penalties**

A person who contravenes a provision of section 1, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred penalty units, and shall forfeit to the Republic the goods on or in connection with which the seal, emblem or designation was used.
